
Skill Transfer Workshop

STRABISMUS, LACRIMAL SAC SURGERIES AND ANTERIOR SEGMENT Organized by Department of Ophthalmology Ramaiah Medical College & Hospitals on 1st & 2nd of November'2017 With limited delegates. Which includes Hands-on Sessions, Under the Guidance of eminent Faculties.



The 36th Annual conference of Karnataka Ophthalmic Society is here in Bengaluru. The prestigious Bangalore Ophthalmic Society is conducting the conference with the theme of "Ophthalmic Universe... be a part of it".

The Department of Ophthalmology, Ramaiah Medical College is organizing a Preconference workshop. It is the first of its kind where we are going to have an amalgamation of minds, the inquisitive fresher to the stalwarts of ophthalmology who are going to be engaged in invigorative discussions.

It will be three workshops spread over 2days on November 1st and 2nd, 2017, at The Advanced Learning center, Ramaiah Medical College, Bengaluru.

The first day is dedicated to the interesting but the ever-eluding subject of Strabismus & Lacrimal Sac surgeries. This session will be mainly cadaver or video demonstration for the delegates so that they understand the principles before they go on to do hands- on procedure. This will give a unique opportunity to learn the skill for the novice, prune the skill for the young practitioners and to pass on the skill and their knowledge for the senior consultants.

Strabismus Workshop: A basic workshop aiming at principles of Recession and Resection and its various modifications. We will be having a brief session of lectures on the anatomy and principles of recession and resection. The delegates will have an opportunity to practice these techniques on the cadaver under expert guidance.

Lacrimal Sac Surgeries: The workshop also conducted on Nov 1st 2017, will entice learning the basic anatomy of the lacrimal sac area, basic skill for a successful DCR, its variations. There will also be a demonstration of endonasal DCR, concentrating on the anatomical landmarks which will be a necessary step for candidates interested in learning endonasal DCR. The delegates will get hands – on cadaver training by experts on external DCR and will be able to learn the skill of silicon intubation.

Ocular Trauma: The second day will be dedicated to Anterior Segment Ocular trauma. This is a topic that every ophthalmologist needs to be prepared as a welldone first surgery is the best chance that the patient gets. There is no scope for mistakes and any ophthalmologist needs to be prepared to the varied presentations and their management.

The topics covered will include the most commonly encountered cases such as lid tear, canalicular tear, corneal tear and scleral tear. There will be video demonstration of cases followed by hands-on cadaver training on the above-mentioned topics.
