The pupils offer crucial neuro-ophthalmic insights. Their size, shape, and reactivity reflect the integrity of afferent visual and efferent autonomic pathways. Abnormalities like afferent pupillary defects (e.g., Marcus Gunn) or anisocoria (e.g., Horner's, Adie's) localize lesions in the optic nerve, brainstem, or autonomic nervous system, aiding diagnosis of various neurological conditions affecting vision. It highlights how the pupils, as direct windows into the autonomic nervous system and afferent visual pathways, serve as critical diagnostic tools, often revealing underlying neurological or systemic conditions that might otherwise be missed. Meticulous pupillary examination is fundamental to neuro-ophthalmology. For ophthalmologists and ophthalmologists in the making, pupil examination is vital. These skills enable early diagnosis of serious neurological conditions affecting vision, guiding appropriate referrals and improving patient outcomes.




